"Note on data changes: Compared to our 2017 annual report, the number of CTE degrees/certificates with job placement set-standards (Items 16 and 17) has been changed for 2015 and 2016. We changed our method for tracking this data to our local curriculum database â€" rather than California Community College Chancellor's Office data. The numbers for 2015/2016 were updated for the sake of consistency. Moreover, the number of degrees/certificates with licensure pass rates was changed to include one additional program â€" Sonography. Additionally, set standards for items 12, 13, 14, and 15 were changed fo r the 2016 year relative to our 2017 annual report. The 2016 reporting year is the first year of our accreditation cycle. We developed a new method of determining set standards/stretch

goals for this accreditation cycle, and therefore, we updated the 2016 year accordingly.

Note on set standard method: The set standards for items 12, 13, 14, and 15 were determined by first calculating the standard deviation for each metric (e.g., success rate) for the five year period from 2010-2011 to 2014-2015. This standard deviation was multiplied by 1.96 and subtracted from the average for the same five year period. The result of this calculation was a "cut-off†for a statistically significant decrease in a given metric. We used this cut-off for each metric as our set standard. For job placement rates, the California Community College Chancellors Office negotiates a goal with our district every year. We use this as our set standard for job placement rates. Finally, for licensure pass rates, the set-standard of 80% was determined by the Careers and Technology Dean and department chairs.

Note on job placement rates: With regards to job placement rates, Cosumnes River College (CRC) uses Perkins ""Core Indicators"" employment data provided by the California Community College Chancellors Office. The employment rates are listed by ""Taxonomy of Programs"" code (TOP Code). CRC has several degrees/certificates within many of the TOP Codes, so the job placement rates in this report have been reported by general area. For example, Automotive Technology represents several certificates/degrees with the same TOP Code. These job placement rates do not include self-employment, so they may underestimate actual employment rates. Additionally, several areas were not listed because sample sizes were less than 10 for the 2016 reporting year: Agriculture Technology and Sciences, General, Horticulture, Landscape Design Maintenance, Nursery Technology, Agricultural Business, Construction Crafts Technology, Welding Technology, Emergency Medical Services, Nutrition, Dietetic Servic es, Marketing, Advertising, Radio/Radio Production, Broadcast Journalism, Film, Digital Media, Photography, Business and Commerce, Taxation, Finance, Small Business Entrepreneurship, Retail Management, E-Business, Business Office Assistant, Web Design, Desktop Publishing, Information Technology, Computer Information Systems, Software Applications, Database Design, Computer Security, Computer Support, Child Development Administration, Infants and Toddlers, Chemical Dependency Studies, and Geographic Information Systems. Finally, there was no Sonography graduating cohort in 2016. This program graduates students on a two year cycle. Therefore, licensure pass rates were not reported for Sonography.
