MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITY CONTRACT (MRC)

STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDES:

All students admitted into the EOPS/CARE programs at CRC are required to sign the MRC at the conclusion of the New Student Orientation. This document is meant to serve as a reminder of both the student's commitment to the program as well as the programs commitment to the student.

As a student of the EOPS/CARE program, there are certain obligations that you must fulfill **each semester** to remain compliant with the program and be eligible for continued participation. These obligations include the following:

- ↔ Enroll in a minimum of TWELVE (12) units each semester at CRC
- ↔ Maintain an overall Grade Point Average of 2.00 or better
- ↔ Notify the EOPS/CARE program of any changes in your class schedule
- ↔ Attend an EOPS and/or CARE Orientation
- ↔ Meet the THREE (3) required contacts

Additional eligibility requirements EOPS/CARE students should be aware of include:

- ↔ Program eligibility is limited to no more than 70 degree applicable units
- ↔ You must adhere to all conditions of the EOPS/CARE book service program
- ↔ You must notify the EOPS/CARE office of any changes to your name, phone number and/or address

CARE Students are also required to meet the following additional obligations:

- ↔ Attend a minimum of ONE (1) workshop per semester and submit verification of participation
- ↔ Notify the CARE program of any changes in income
- ↔ Notify the CARE program of any changes in household status

PROGRAM RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- ↔ Workshops

- ↔ Transfer Assistance
