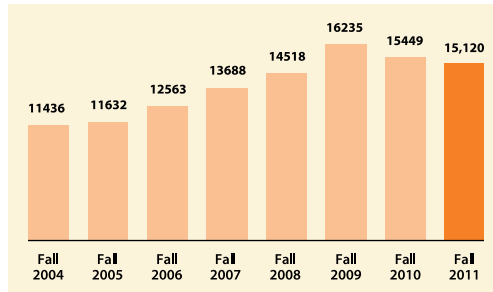

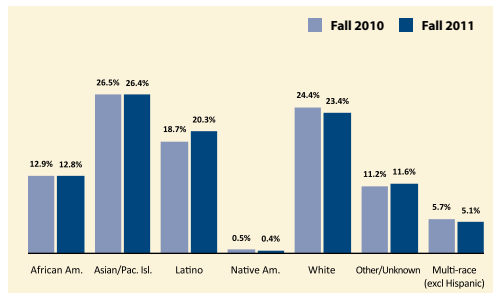

ENROLLMENT



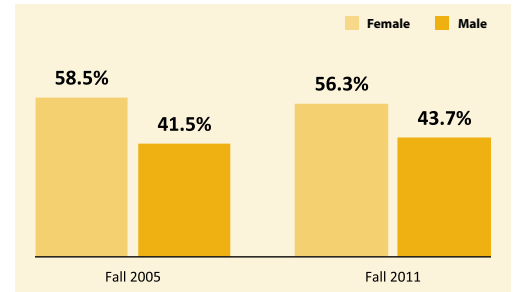

ETHNICITY



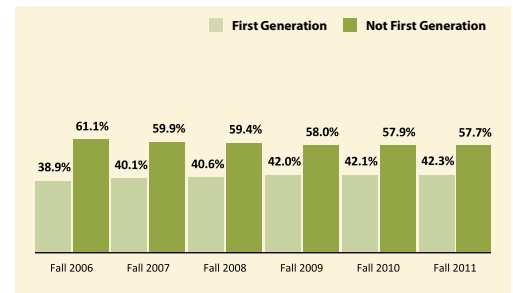

GENDER



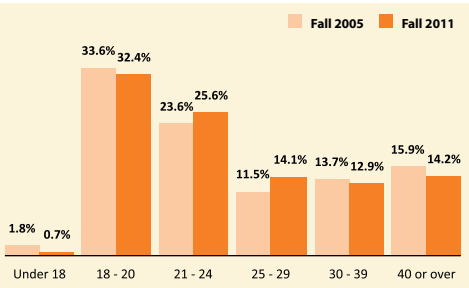

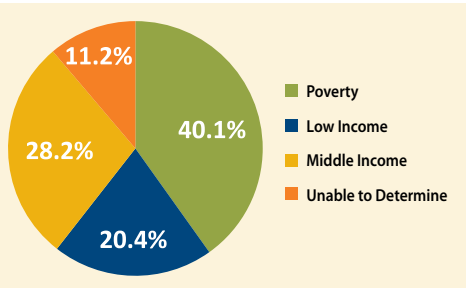

STUDENTS BY AGE GROUP



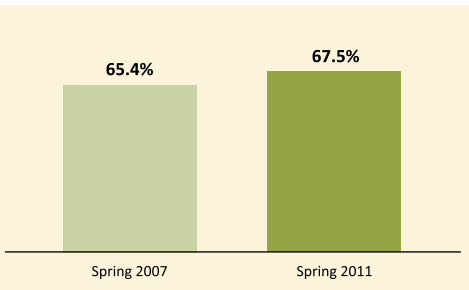

STUDENTS BY INCOME LEVEL



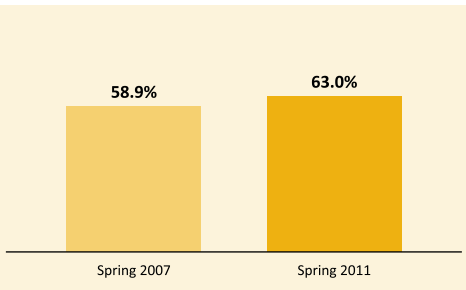
