CRC HISTORY

Cosumnes River College is one of four community colleges within the Los Rios Community College District. The college opened on September 14, 1970, with 1,800 day and 350 evening students. Facilities included the science building, automotive and technology complex, women's physical education building, pool, and the library building.

In September 1975, the Business/Social Science classroom building was dedicated, the first since the college opened. The computer laboratory, located there, is equipped with state-

of-the-art data processing equipment that supports many areas of the college curriculum.

There are almost 14,000 students enrolled at Cosumnes River. The college offers a broad option of more than 60 occupational degree programs, and a comprehensive curriculum of transfer courses.

Cosumnes River College has emerged with very much its own identity, small enough to offer personalized attention, yet large enough to offer a comprehensive postsecondary education to the community it serves.

STUDENT PROFILE

CRC enjoys one of the most diverse college campuses in the region. Almost 60% of our students are under 25 years of age and almost 60% are female. There are more than 40 languages spoken on campus.

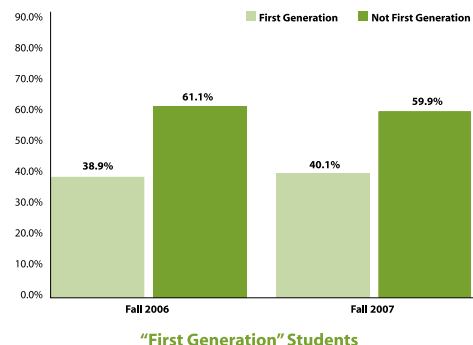
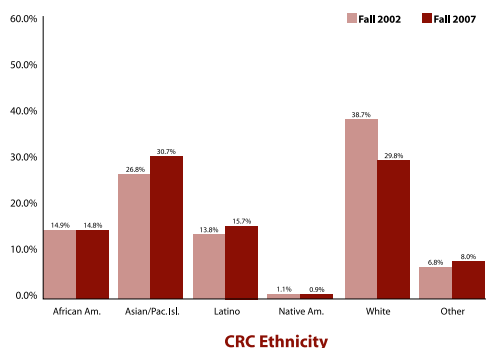
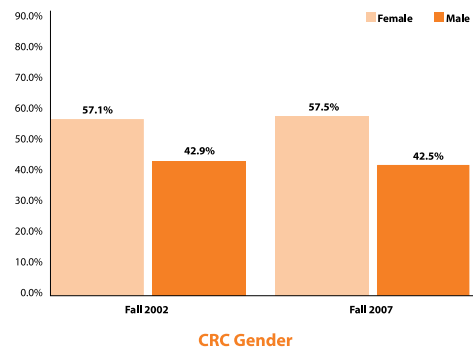
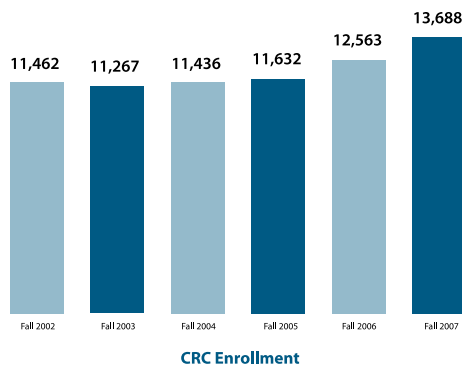
In the future, CRC will build an educational center in the city of Elk Grove to accommodate our projected growth.

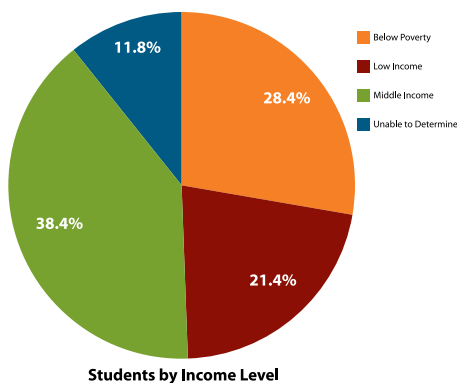
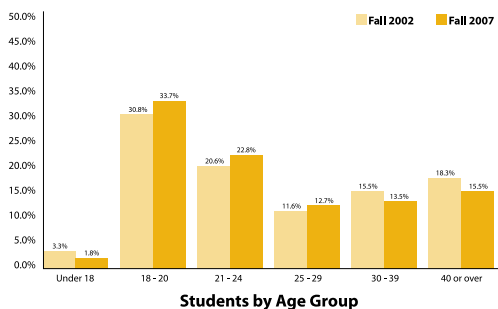
PLANNING FOR GROWTH
