Cosumnes River College continues to transform its campus with new programs and facilities to better serve our students and community who look to CRC for access to higher education to improve their career and life prospects.


The college's Elk Grove Center serves students looking for a smaller, more intimate learning environment and has proven to be a huge asset to the community.

GENDER*








STUDENT PROFILE STUDENTS BY AGE GROUP




STUDENT PROFILE STUDENTS BY INCOME LEVEL
