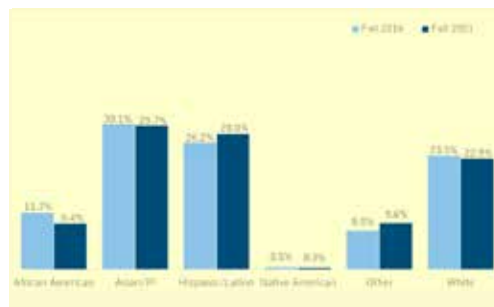


STUDENT PROFILE GENDER*

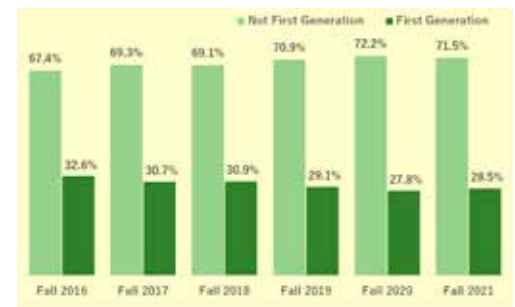

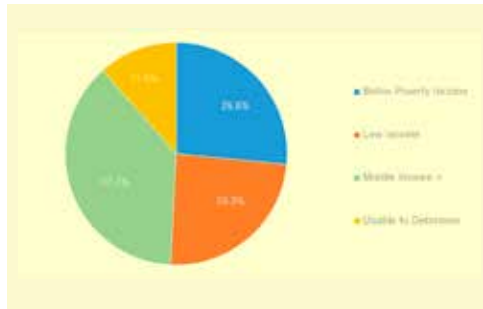

STUDENTS BY AGE GROUP



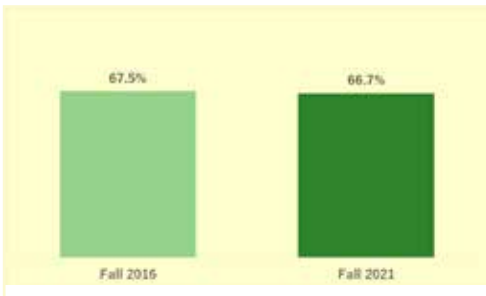
