The college is constantly finding ways to benefit the local community and we invite you to visit our campus and take a class or two!

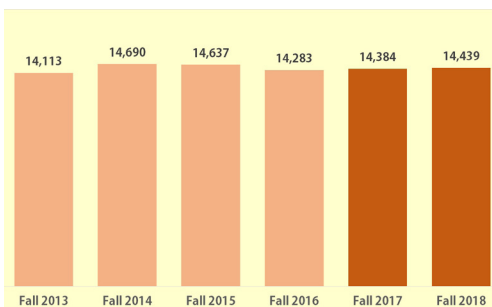

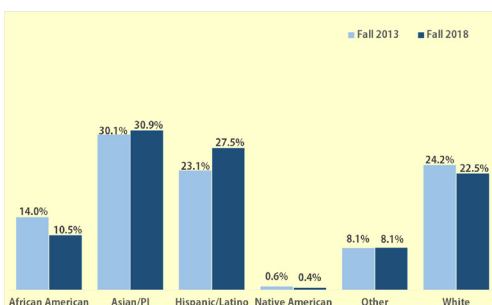

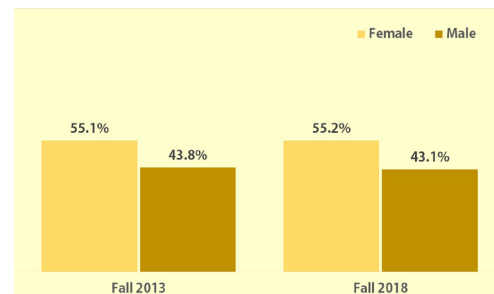
### STUDENT PROFILE | COSUMNES RIVER COLLEGE ENROLLMENT



### STUDENT PROFILE | COSUMNES RIVER COLLEGE ETHNICITY

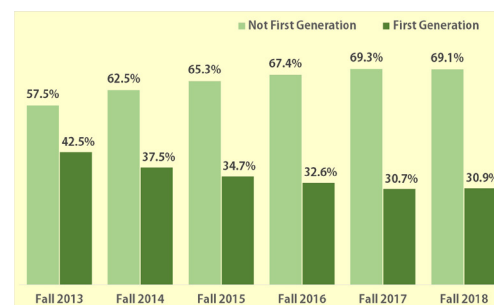


### STUDENT PROFILE | COSUMNES RIVER COLLEGE GENDER\*



\*A small percentage of students declined to state their gender

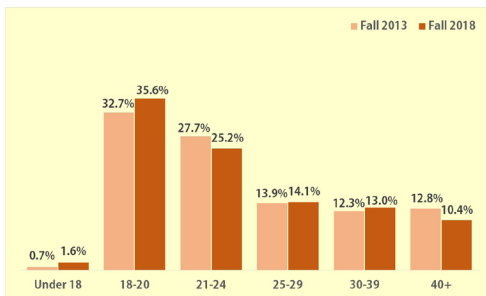

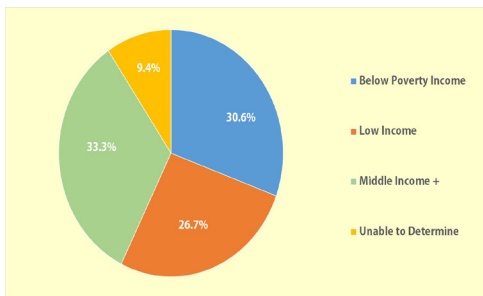

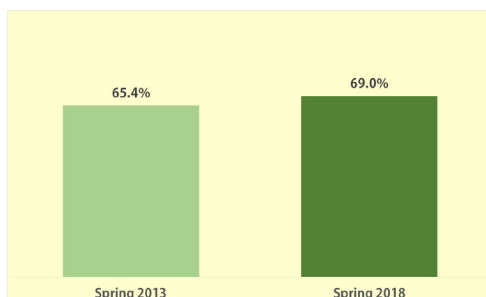

STUDENTS BY AGE GROUP



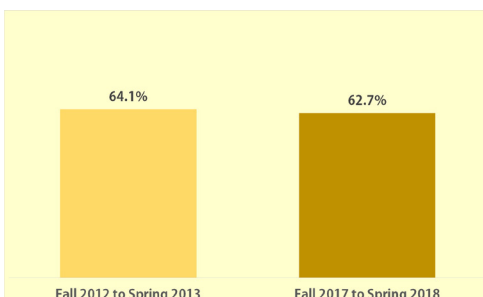
